

Student Prize of the Mediterranean Network of Engineering and Management Schools and Faculties

The student Prize of the Mediterranean Network of Engineering and Management Schools (**RMEI-M**) and its partners, amounting to **1000 Euros**, is intended to reward a young graduate in engineering or management, from a member institution of the RMEI-M, whose work is fully in line with the themes defined annually by the organizing committee of the Prize.

The candidates to the **RMEI-M prize** must be students regularly registered in the calendar year preceding (for example academic year 2020/2021 for the GA 2022) the attribution of the prize in member institutions of the RMEI-M, up to date with their subscription, and have obtained their diploma (**engineer, master or MBA**) in the year also preceding the attribution of the prize. The winner will be selected by the members of the **RMEI-M Prize** Organizing Committee.

The award will be delivered during a dedicated session at the RMEI-M General Assembly.

1) HOW TO APPLY

Submit a file via the RMEIM website <https://rmei.info>. The file must include the following documents:

- Europass CV (in english).
- An abstract of the final year project / Master Thesis. The abstract should be in English, with **a maximum of 3000 characters** (not including spaces, i.e. about one A4 page), including **title and bibliography + a summary figure. The format is pdf.**
- The Master thesis or the final report (**pdf format**).

Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. Applicants will receive an acknowledgement of receipt.

2) RECRUITMENT

The applications will be evaluated by experts appointed by the Committee members. On the basis of these evaluations, the Committee will select the winner who will be notified at a later date and invited to present his or her work during the award ceremony at the General Assembly.
